MBLY

Mobileye develops ADAS and autonomous-driving systems (EyeQ SoCs, software, mapping, and AV stack) sold through OEM and Tier-1 programs.

ASML

ASML designs and manufactures lithography systems used to produce semiconductors, plus related software, upgrades, and field services.

BWXT

BWXT manufactures nuclear reactor components and fuels for U.S. defense programs and provides commercial nuclear services and medical isotope/radiopharma supply.

This Week's Directional Theme

This week's signal is mixed but structurally supportive: real-economy buildouts and enterprise adoption continue to compound, while regulatory, construction, and capital-markets frictions rise. U.S. energy—cloud partnerships are explicitly coupling gigawatt-scale data centers with new generation, reinforcing the compute—power flywheel, even as Oracle-linked buildout headlines and Al-capex selloffs underscore timeline and funding constraints. Enterprise deployment is accelerating (banking, IT, and legal) with rapid scaling metrics (e.g., Glean doubling ARR in ~9 months). Resistance is concentrated in governance: EU antitrust scrutiny of training/distribution data, escalating IP enforcement, and widening disclosure/labeling mandates (NY, South Korea),...

Sectors on the Move

- ▶ Biotech ↑ as milestone paths de-risk (gene-editing HAE, IO combos; Aldriven small-molecule platforms get more runway)
- Quantum/defense & mobility hardware ↑ on commercialization signals (photonics volume pitch, hybrid QC SKUs, UAS bookings, silicon-anode scaling)
- ➤ Crypto & in-car voice AI ↓ where value capture/financing risks grow (BTC-treasury leverage, interchain fees lag, automaker assistant competition)

- ▶ Top gainers: NTLA, HURA, QUBT, MATIC, AUR
- Notable upward movers: NTLA, HURA, QUBT, MATIC, AVAV
- Notable downward movers: DNA, APUS, MSTR, ATOM, CRNC
